The introduced budget achieves several goals:

- (1) accesses technology to promote opportunities for operation efficiencies,
- (2) includes meaningful funding allocations for the preservation and safe maintenance of bridge assets,
- (3) accommodates the Commission's long-term goal to pursue green energy and environmentally friendly alternatives, including the facilitation of EV charging stations
- (4) manage line item costs to offset the impact of inflation, and
- (5) reallocates appropriations to reflect privatization of toll collection function.

The report of Healthcare (N-5) is impacted by the parameters of the State template. BCBC Retiree healthcare benefits have a two tier cost structure. For retirees under aged 65 or not yet participating in Medicare Part B the fee structure follows that of employees. For Medicare Part B participating retirees the fee structure is reduced and is a supplemental plan. For BCBC's FY '24 budget reported costs were adjusted to comply with the form. For FY '25 management made a determination to update the form for presentation and so readers could better interpret the data. In future years BCBC anticipates utilizing entry data in the updated form. Note: the actual increase in healthcare budgeted for FY '25 is approximately 4%. This calculation is limited by actual amounts charged for claims as the result of self-insurance funding.

The regions that support the Burlington County Bridge Commission Toll Revenue Bridges show much promise of positive Economic Development. The redevelopment and growth of the Route 130 Corridor specifically has been tremendously successful. Throughout 2023 and 2024, progress in Burlington County has introduced significant development with new commercial warehouses built throughout the County, as well as significant residential new construction.

The Commission does not utilize written employment contracts and instead considers an offer letter paired with job description to establish the terms of employment. There is a long, established employment history for each of these management roles as the Commission's administrative structure has been stable and efficient for decades. When compared to other similarly situated entities the Commission's administration is lien and factually the number of management staff has been on a downward trend for years. The Police Department salries are determined through a contract.
